Introduction to Blacksmithing is designed for those with an interest in learning the fundamentals of blacksmithing. The class will bring a small group

of students into the mining park's blacksmith shop where students will work hands-on with a coal burning forge and learn to forge iron into useful and decorative items. The students will learn to light and work with a coal forge to heat metal to more than red hot and then to use hammers and other tools to forge, bend and twist the hot metal to desired shapes.
