## TONOPAH TOWN BOARD MEETING MINUTES OCTOBER 23, 2013

Tonopah Town Board Chairman Horace Carlyle called the meeting to order October 23, 2013 at 7:00 p.m. Also present was Ron Kipp and Janet Hatch. There were four (4) others present.

- 1. Public Comment. None. No action taken by the Board.
- 2. Review and approval of minutes, in context, from the regular meeting held on October 9, 2013.

Ron Kipp motioned to approve the minutes, in context, from the regular meeting held on September 25, 2013 as presented. Janet Hatch seconded. No further discussion. Motion carried 3-0.

3. Discussion and possible action to authorize Town Staff to work with individuals interested in beautifying town property/parks, provided proposals do not interfere with infrastructure of Town property/parks.

Town Manager James Eason explained that a request was made from a community member to plant a tree in one of the parks in memory of an individual. Mr. Eason stated he would like the board to authorize the staff to use their discretion when these requests come in. Janet Hatch asked who would be responsible to ensure that invasive plants would not be allowed. Mr. Eason responded that although the Town does not have an "expert" on staff, each case will be considered and researched to ensure the preservation of existing plants.

Ron Kipp motioned to authorize Town Staff to work with individuals interested in beautifying town property/parks, provided proposal do not interfere with infrastructure of Town property/parks. Janet Hatch seconded. No further discussion. Motion carried 3-0.

Janet Hatch motioned to adopt an Ordinance Enacting a Revision and Codification of the general ordinances of the Town of Tonopah, Town of Tonopah Bill No. TTO-13-04; a Bill proposing to amend Title 22 of the Nye County Code, by repealing Chapter 22.36 titled Motorcycles, and adding a new Chapter 22.36 titled Motorcycles and Similar Vehicles, by adopting by reference Nevada Revised Statutes Chapter 486 Regulating the Operation of Motorcycles; providing for the severability, constitutionality and effective date therefore, and other matters relating thereto. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after the 20<sup>th</sup> day of the month of November, 2013. Ron Kipp seconded. No further discussion. Motion carried 3-0.

7. Discussion, deliberation and possible action to authorize Town staff to submit an agenda item request to the Nye County Board of County Commissioners for their next available meeting; Tonopah Town Board strongly supports and recommends the Nye County Board of County Commissioners consider a Bill to amend the Nye County Code, to adopt by reference Nevada Revised Statutes 490.082, 490.083, 490.090, 490.120, 490.130 and 490.520(3), regulating the operation of Off-Highway Vehicles within the boundaries of the Town of Tonopah, in whole as if the same were set out in the Nye County Code in its entirety, and as Sections 490.082, 490.083, 490.090, 490.120, 490.130 and 490.520(3), may be amended by the State legislature in the future with respect to the streets and highways under its jurisdiction and within the reasonable exercise of its police powers.

This item was tabled by the board.
