- Participants must submit a \$20.00 entry fee with this entry form by Cash, Check or Money Order payable to TDC/Jim Butler Days.
- Participants must be available **Saturday, May 18th at 3:00 PM** for practice at the Tonopah Convention Center. No exceptions. Tonopah Tiny Tots division must be accompanied by an adult.
- If participants talent includes music, it must be dropped off to Rebecca Fry no later than **Monday, May 13th**. Any other props may be dropped off at the Sunday practice time. NO GLITTER or anything resulting in extreme cleaning.
- You and your child must have good sportsmanship, even if your daughter is not chosen.
- Once crowned, the five winners must be available during Jim Butler Days to be present at a few functions and to be introduced in their sash and crown.
- All girls are encouraged to help build, and ride on the float during the parade, on Saturday morning. Parents please participate with your child.
- All entries must be paid for and given to Rebecca Fry or Shannon Stringer on or before the deadline of **Wednesday, May 1st at 5:00 PM**.
- A very limited amount of donated dresses are available to choose from, if needed. Please contact Rebecca Fry to set up an appointment.

### Each contestant will be judged on presentation, poise and attire on the following:

- A talent lasting 3 minutes or less (Tonopah Tiny Tots will do a group performance)
