The Tonopah Community Endowment Fund Scholarship is a one-time award of \$1,000.00 for students graduating from Tonopah High School (THS) in 2022 and continuing their education at an accredited college or university; a one-time award of \$1,000.00 for students graduating from THS in 2022 and continuing their education at a vocational training school; and a one-time award of \$500.00 to a THS graduate, or resident of Tonopah for at least 5 years who pursuing higher education.

A point system will be used to determine each award winner, with the criteria to be rated including: grade point average, extracurricular activities such as school sports/club participation, community service, honors classes taken, employment history, the essay portion of the application and letters of recommendation (at least two).
