American Battery Technology Company (ABTC) is advancing the proposed Tonopah Flats Lithium Project in Big Smoky Valley, targeting one of the nation's largest known claystone lithium resources. The project is planned for approximately 10,700 acres of public land in Esmeralda and Nye Counties, located about five miles west of the Town of Tonopah

ABTC proposes a single pit with dry stack tailings to be mined over 60+ years, along with an adjacent refinery that is designed to mill 37,700 tons per day. Designed to be powered by clean energy generated just north of the highway, ABTC intends to construct a solar photovoltaic field with battery storage. Associated on site infrastructure includes a substation, power lines, drilled monitoring and supply wells, stormwater and sediment control, and a network of surface piping and access roads.
